



Broward County ranks as the second-most populous county in the state, following Miami-Dade County, with a population of 1,944,375 according to the 2020 census. Fort Lauderdale serves as both the county seat and the largest city, with a population of 182,760. The area's original inhabitants were the Tequesta people, who inhabited much of southeastern Florida, including present-day Broward County, Miami-Dade County, and the southern portion of Palm Beach County. The Tequesta were primarily engaged in fishing, hunting, and foraging for fruits and roots, lacking any agricultural practices. In their burial customs, they interred smaller bones with the body while placing larger bones in a box for the community's viewing. They are also recognized for creating the Miami Circle. Broward County was established on April 30, 1915, originally proposed to be called Everglades County, but the bill was changed by Ion Farris, then-Speaker of the Florida House of Representatives, to honor Napoleon Bonaparte Broward, who served as Florida's governor from 1905 to 1909.

CORAL SPRINGS

Located in Broward County, Florida, Coral Springs is a city situated about 20 miles northwest of Fort Lauderdale. According to the U.S. Census conducted in 2020, its population stood at 134,394. The city was officially chartered on July 10, 1963, and was primarily developed through a master plan by Coral Ridge Properties, Inc., a company that Westinghouse acquired in 1966. The name of the city was chosen based on this company's name after various other suggestions had been evaluated and dismissed. Throughout the 1970s, 1980s, and 1990s, the city experienced significant growth, with more than 35,000 new residents added in each decade.

FORT LAUDERDALE

Located in the state of Florida, Fort Lauderdale is a coastal city positioned 30 miles north of Miami along the Atlantic Ocean. It serves as the county seat and is the largest city in Broward County, with a population of 182,760 according to the 2020 census, ranking it as the tenth most populous city in Florida. The area that would eventually become Fort Lauderdale was occupied for over two millennia by the Tequesta Indians. Their interaction with Spanish explorers in the 16th century had catastrophic consequences, as the Europeans introduced diseases like smallpox, to which the indigenous people had no immunity. Prior to the 20th century, the region was referred to as the "New River Settlement." In the 1830s, around 70 settlers resided along the New River. Established in 1838 and officially incorporated in 1911, Fort Lauderdale derives its name from a series of forts erected by the United States during the Second Seminole War. These fortifications were named after Major William Lauderdale (1782–1838), the younger sibling of Lieutenant Colonel James Lauderdale. The initial stockade known as Fort Lauderdale was constructed in 1838 and became a battleground during the Second Seminole War. The fort was decommissioned in 1842 following the conflict, and the surrounding area remained largely uninhabited until the 1890s. It wasn't until Frank Stranahan arrived in 1893 to run a ferry service across the New River, along with the Florida East Coast Railroad completing a route through the area in 1896, that structured development began. The city was formally incorporated in 1911 and was recognized as the county seat of the newly established Broward County in 1915.

HOLLYWOOD

Located in Broward County, Florida, Hollywood had a population of 153,067 as of 2020. In 1920, Joseph Young made his way to South Florida with the intention of establishing what he called his “Dream City in Florida.” His aspirations encompassed the Atlantic Ocean’s beaches extending westward, alongside artificially created lakes, roads, infrastructure, and the Intracoastal Waterway. Young envisioned large parks, schools, churches, and golf courses, all of which were significant to his concept of community. After investing millions in the city’s development, he became its inaugural mayor in 1925. The area quickly attracted northerners, affectionately referred to as “snowbirds,” who sought refuge from the cold winters and sweltering summers. By 1960, Hollywood boasted over 2,400 hotel rooms and 12,170 single-family residences. Around 1920, Young acquired thousands of acres of land, naming his new city “Hollywood by the Sea” to set it apart from his other property development, “Hollywood in the Hills,” based in New York.

MIRAMAR

Located in the southern part of Broward County, Florida, Miramar had a population of 134,721 according to the 2020 census. The city was established by A.L. Mailman to act as a residential area for the adjacent cities of Miami and Fort Lauderdale. In 1953, Mailman acquired the initial land for development from H.D. Perry Sr. He constructed 56 affordable concrete homes with flat roofs, which sold rapidly due to their low prices for both the houses and the land, thus leading to the formation of Miramar. Miramar officially became a city on May 26, 1955, named after the Miramar neighborhood in Havana, Cuba, where Mailman had a summer residence (the name Miramar means “look at the sea” in Spanish). At its incorporation, the population was fewer than 200 individuals. Covering about 2.9 square miles, the city’s original borders were defined by Southwest 64 Avenue to the east, University Drive to the west, the Dade County line to the south, and Pembroke Road to the north. On June 20, 1955, Robert Gordon was sworn in as the first mayor along with the city council, all appointed by the governor to serve until the first elections in January 1959. Mayor Robert Gordon is credited with naming the city, which features the motto “Beauty and Progress” on its seal.

PEMBROKE PINES

Pembroke Pines is located in the southern part of Broward County, Florida, with a population of 171,178 as recorded by the 2020 census. Originally, the area was inhabited by Native Americans, who settled there approximately 4,000 years ago. Evidence, such as skeletal remains of animal hunters dating back around 10,000 years, has been discovered in Broward County, indicating that humans may have resided in the region even earlier. The community began as farmland used for dairy operations and expanded after World War II, as returning veterans settled in the area. This included large eastern portions that were previously part of Waldrep Dairy Farm and now house the Pembroke Lakes Mall. The initial two subdivisions adopted the name Pembroke Pines. The city was officially incorporated on January 16, 1960. The origin of the name Pembroke Pines can be traced to Sir Edward J. Reed, a British Parliament member representing Pembroke County from 1874 to 1880. In 1882, he established the Florida Land and Mortgage Company to acquire nearly 2 million acres of primarily swampland from Hamilton Disston across the southern region of Florida. A road running through one of these parcels became known as Pembroke Road. During the city’s incorporation, Walter Smith Kipnis, the inaugural mayor, proposed the name Pembroke Pines due to the nearby pine trees. Kipnis’s own residence, built in 1956, was one of the earliest homes in the city.

POMPANO BEACH

Pompano Beach, located in Broward County, Florida, had a population of 112,046 according to the 2020 census. The name of the city comes from the Florida pompano (*Trachinotus carolinus*), a species of fish native to the Atlantic coast. Although there were a few settlers in the region since the mid-1880s, the first permanent residents documented in the Pompano area were George Butler and Frank Sheen along with their families, who arrived in 1896 as employees of the railroad. The inaugural train reached the small settlement of Pompano on February 22, 1896. Legend has it that Sheen named the community after writing down the name of the fish he dined on while surveying the area. The arrival of the railroad spurred expansion further inland from the coast. In 1906, Pompano became the southernmost settlement in the newly established Palm Beach County, coinciding with the completion of the Hillsboro Lighthouse that same year. On July 3, 1908, Pompano was incorporated as a municipality within what was then Dade County, with John R. Mizell serving as its first mayor. In 1915, the formation of Broward County defined its northern boundary at the Hillsboro Canal, resulting in Pompano having been part of three different counties in just eight years.



If you have just rescued / adopted a new fur baby, please it is important to remember the 3-3-3 RULE:

3 Days:

In the first 3 days being in its new home, they will be feeling overwhelmed, scared & unsure of what is going on. They may also be uncomfortable being "themselves", and may not want to eat or drink. They may want to "shut down" or hide under a bed or in a crate, and they will test boundaries.

3 Weeks:

At this point, they may be a lot more comfortable & settling in. Learning a new routine can be overwhelming, so please be patient. By now they may have figured out the new environment & accepted that this may be their FURever home. Their personality traits will start to show, as well as any behavior issue that may be present.

3 Months:

For most fur babies, 3 months is enough time to finally be comfortable and begin to build trust and a true bond. A sense of security may be present & a set routine will help this process.

Please know that this is not the rule with every rescued or adopted pet, as some may need 6 months to a year to adjust & adapt, depending on MANY factors. Age of animal, what type of an environment did they come from?

Beach Flag WARNING COLORS

Beach flags are commonly used to communicate important information to beachgoers. The color-coded flag system may vary slightly from one location to another, but the following are commonly recognized color meanings:

Blue Flag: This flag is used to signify that lifeguards are on duty and that the area is being actively monitored for safety.

Green Flag: Indicates that it is safe to swim. The water conditions are generally calm, & there is a low risk of hazards such as strong currents or high waves.

Yellow Flag: Caution is advised. This flag suggests that there may be some hazards present, such as moderate surf or currents.

Red Flag: A red flag indicates high hazards & potentially dangerous water conditions. It is a warning that strong currents, high surf, or other dangers are present. It is advised to stay out of the water.

Double Red Flags: This is a more severe warning, & it typically means that the beach is closed to the public. Dangerous conditions, such as strong rip currents or severe weather, pose a significant threat.

Purple Flag: This flag is used to indicate the presence of dangerous marine life, such as sharks or jellyfish. It is advised to exercise caution.
