

St. Johns County History



Located in the northeastern region of Florida, St. Johns County is a part of the United States. According to the 2020 census, the county had a population of 273,425. St. Augustine serves as both the county seat and the most populous incorporated city in the area. The origins of St. Johns County trace back to 1821 when Colonel Robert Butler acquired Spanish East Florida from Captain-General Colonel José M. Coppinger. Representing Major General Andrew Jackson, who served as the federal military commissioner for the Florida provinces (las Floridas), Butler held the powers of a governor and executed the authority of the Captain General as well as the Intendants of the Island of Cuba and the governors of those provinces. It was determined that all land east of the Suwannee River would be named St. Johns County.

St. Johns was officially created on July 21, 1821, alongside Escambia County (from the former West Florida province), just 11 days after Butler received Florida for the United States and five days subsequent to the incorporation of St. Augustine. The name "Saint John's" originated from the Spanish mission known as San Juan del Puerto, which dates back to around 1580 ("Saint John of the Harbor"). In 1932, the U.S. Department of the Interior removed the apostrophe from the name, as it suggested ownership.

St. Augustine, the county seat of St. Johns County, is a city situated 40 miles south of downtown Jacksonville along the Atlantic coast of northeastern Florida. Established in 1565 by Spanish explorers, it holds the distinction of being the oldest continuously inhabited European-initiated settlement in the present-day contiguous United States. The founding of St. Augustine took place on September 8, 1565, led by Spanish Admiral Pedro Menéndez de Avilés, who was also the first governor of Florida. He named the settlement San Agustín in honor of the day his ships, carrying settlers, soldiers, and supplies from Spain, first spotted land in Florida on August 28, coinciding with the feast day of St. Augustine. For over two centuries, the city served as the capital of Spanish Florida. When the British East Florida colony was created in 1763, it was named the capital, but Florida was returned to Spain in 1783. In 1819, Spain transferred Florida to the United States, and as a result of the Adams–Onís Treaty ratification in 1821, St. Augustine became one of two alternating capitals of the Florida Territory, alongside Pensacola. That same year, the Florida National Guard established its headquarters in the city. However, in 1824, the territorial government relocated and established Tallahassee as the permanent capital of Florida. St. Augustine belongs to the First Coast region of Florida and is part of the Jacksonville, Florida Metropolitan Statistical Area. According to the 2020 census, its population was recorded at 14,329.

St. Augustine Beach

Located in St. Johns County, Florida, St. Augustine Beach is a city that had a population of 6,803 according to the 2020 US census. It became incorporated in the year 1959.



"She sees things through light and prisms and that reflects in her paintings. It's almost like they're glowing," says Sweet.

Or consider Al Razza, with a master's degree from the illustrious Rhode Island School of Design. The professor and artist opened his own art academy in Boca Raton, FL, and has shown solo at the Coral Springs Museum in Coral Springs, FL. "As soon as that show ended all of that art came to the gallery," says Sweet.

Both galleries offer In-home showings to allow customers to view the art in their own space before buying. We offer approachable galleries that assist clients in building collections of value. "The process of collecting art should be enjoyable and educational," says Sweet.

Beach flags are commonly used to communicate important information to beachgoers. The color-coded flag system may vary slightly from one location to another, but the following are commonly recognized color meanings:

Blue Flag: This flag is used to signify that lifeguards are on duty and that the area is being actively monitored for safety.

Green Flag: Indicates that it is safe to swim. The water conditions are generally calm, & there is a low risk of hazards such as strong currents or high waves.

Yellow Flag: Caution is advised. This flag suggests that there may be some hazards present, such as moderate surf or currents.

Red Flag: A red flag indicates high hazards & potentially dangerous water conditions. It is a warning that strong currents, high surf, or other dangers are present. It is advised to stay out of the water.

Double Red Flags: This is a more severe warning, & it typically means that the beach is closed to the public. Dangerous conditions, such as strong rip currents or severe weather, pose a significant threat.

Purple Flag: This flag is used to indicate the presence of dangerous marine life, such as sharks or jellyfish. It is advised to exercise caution.

Rip currents are powerful, narrow channels of fast-moving water that can pose a danger to swimmers and surfers. Getting caught in a rip current can be frightening, but knowing how to recognize and handle them can help you stay safe. Here's how to avoid or get out of a rip current in the ocean:

1. Stay Calm & Don't Fight the Current: If you find yourself caught in a rip current, stay calm and try not to panic. Remember that rip currents do not pull swimmers underwater; instead, they pull them away from the shore. Avoid fighting against the current by swimming directly back to shore, as this can lead to exhaustion.

3. Swim Parallel to the Shore: If you feel confident in your swimming abilities, swim parallel to the shoreline instead of trying to swim directly back to shore. Rip currents are typically narrow, so swimming parallel to the shore can help you escape the pull of the current. Once you're out of the rip current, you can then swim back to the shore at an angle.

5. Seek Assistance if Needed: If you're unable to escape the rip current on your own or if you're feeling exhausted, continue to signal for help and wait for assistance from lifeguards or other beachgoers. Don't hesitate to call for help if you need it, as prompt action can prevent a dangerous situation from escalating. 2. Float & Conserve Energy: If you're unable to swim out of the rip current, conserve your energy by floating or treading water. Signal for help by waving your arms and calling for assistance if you see lifeguards or other beachgoers nearby. Most rip currents are narrow, and you will eventually be carried out of the current and into calmer waters.

4. Use Waves to Help You Escape: Wait for waves to push you towards shore and use them to assist your escape from the rip current. Time your movements with the breaking waves, and use the momentum to swim towards the shore. Be patient and persistent, and don't exhaust yourself by attempting to fight against the current.

Always swim at beaches with lifeguards present, heed warning signs, and follow any instructions or advice given by local authorities.

In the first 3 days being in its new home, they will be feeling overwhelmed, scared & unsure of what is going on. They may also be uncomfortable being "themselves", and may not want to eat or drink. They may want to "shut down" or hide under a bed or in a crate, and they will test boundaries.

3 Weeks:

At this point, they may be a lot more comfortable & settling in. Learning a new routine can be overwhelming, so please be patient. By now they may have figured out the new environment & accepted that this may be their FURever home. Their personality traits will start to show, as well as any behavior issue that may be present. **3 Months:**

For most fur babies, 3 months is enough time to finally be comfortable and begin to build trust and a true bond. A sense of security may be present & a set routine will help this process.

Please know that this is not the rule with every rescued or adopted pet, as some may need 6 months to a year to adjust & adapt, depending on MANY factors. Age of animal, what type of an environment did they come from?
